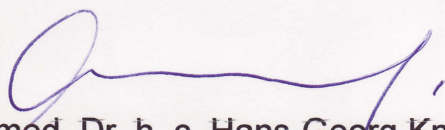
The German "Medical Society for the Use of Ozone in Prevention and Therapy" has been founded in 1971 as a non-profit organisation.

Together with the sister societies in Switzerland, Austria and Italy the "European Cooperation of Medical Ozone Societies" EuroCoop has been founded in 2002

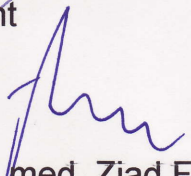
Its aim has been to standardize ozone therapy to the greatest possible extent. In the same way, the member societies will aim at providing mutually valid training & development guidelines, making provisions to the fullest possible extent for all indications and application methods of ozone therapy. In the long run, a European Standard Qualification could become a uniform objective.

In 2006 two associations joined the EuroCoop: the Egyptian Ozone Association starting with the first scientific congress in Cairo in February 2006 and the Turkish Ozone Association organizing their first International Medical Ozone Congress in Istanbul: June 16 – 18, 2006.
